ART & CREATIVE MATERIALS (to be shared in class - no need to label)

- 1 pack of thick, washable markers
- 2 boxes of crayons
- 2 packages of colored pencils
- 4 large glue sticks
- 2 bottles of white liquid glue

PERSONAL ITEMS

- **Daily Clothing-** Please dress your child in lightweight, comfortable clothing that allows for easy movement and can get messy. We provide rich sensory experiences, enabling children to remain active and engaged throughout the day. Sports shoes with Velcro straps (not laces) are preferred for their ease of movement and child independence.
- **An Extra Set of Clothes (including shorts, shirt, socks, and undergarments)** should be returned in the ziplock bag provided by your child's teacher on the first day of school.
- **Lunchbox & Water Bottle** - Easy for your child to open and close independently.
- **Backpack-** Large enough to hold a lunchbox, library books, and a water bottle (no wheels, please).
- **Sunhat-** To protect your child from the intense sun during outdoor play.
- **A Family Photo** - To keep in the classroom and help your child feel connected and comforted throughout the day.

For Pre-K3 and Pre-K4: 1 Blanket or Nap Mat (foldable to fit in a cubby), a small, non-noise-making stuffed animal, and an optional small pillow for rest time; sent home weekly for washing.

OPTIONAL COMMUNITY CONTRIBUTIONS

If you'd like to support our creative and nature-based explorations, we welcome donations of the following open-ended or natural materials throughout the year:

- **Loose parts-** Smooth stones, small rocks, wooden beads, corks, bottle caps, shells, etc.
- **Natural Materials-** Dried flowers, seed pods, palm fronds, or interesting sticks/twigs.
- **Scrap Fabric-** Cotton, linen, or felt (natural materials preferred).
- **Empty Glass Jars-** Clean, small jars for storing natural materials or for use in light play.
- **Cardboard-** Tubes, boxes, or flat sheets for building and imaginative projects
- **Nature Treasures from Home or Travel-** Children love sharing special finds with the class.

FOR KG
